Councillor Anne, having worked in the care profession, in homes for the elderly and seeing several closures over several years whilst working for Dorset County Council the outcomes are not always positive for the residents, families of the staff. If the Council closes Day Centres and cuts respite care for relatives we will have bigger problems down the road and more costly ones too. Bournemouth Church Housing which provides specialist care around the town e.g. the womens refuge, safe houses for Alcoholics etc may have its funding from the Council cut due to the Government cutting our 'Supporting People Grant'

Cutting Local Council Costs

Cllr Derek Borthwick, alongside Council Officers, have been working outside of the ward in trying to save you, the residents, large amounts of money by cutting local Council costs this year.

We have managed to save over 3 million pounds over the next 10 years by changing the way the Bowling Greens in the town are maintained. This is without any redundancies or loss to the Bowls Clubs.

Queens Park Golf Club Catering

The catering at Queens Park Golf Club was running at an annual loss of £50,000 and Cllr Derek has helped, alongside Council Officers and the portfolio holder, to turn this into a potential profit of £10,000 per year by pursuing the change of catering arrangements.

We have endeavoured to supply you with regular newsletters since we were elected as your Ward Councillors. We continue to strive to give you the best personal service within the ward, and strong representation at the Council, and are willing to talk on any matters that concern you.

Local Park Maintenance

Councillor Derek (also representing Councillor Anne and Councillor Ron) was part of an evaluation team which negotiated the new 5 year contract for Tree Cutting and Ground Maintenance of parks and horticulture, covering the Throop, Muscliff, Strouden & Townsend area.

The contract covers cutting grass verges and maintenance of bushes and shrubs. This work was previously carried out by Bournemouth Borough Council and the contract was won by Baynards, a local company, saving around £200,000 over the 5 year term. Plus a 3% annual efficiency savings after 1 year.

This contract also ensures employment of 2 local apprentices. This contract also ensures the previous quality of work will continue. The local council cannot, therefore, make any further budget cuts in this ward.

Muscliff Funday

The Muscliff Funday last summer was a great success, possibly the largest local funday in Bournemouth, which raised over £1,000 towards the local Community Centre and other worthy causes. Cllr Anne and Cllr Derek will be staying on the Funday committee, all the members of this committee are very hard working. We are always looking for more local residents to join the committee.

The next Muscliff Funday will be held on **Sunday, 17th July 2011 11am - 4pm**

Cllr Anne, Cllr Ron and Cllr Derek have also helped with the following:

- managed to get the public toilets open in Muscliff Park during the school summer term.
- found funding for the River Stour signage
- in the process of ensuring the ancient Gas Lamps in Throop village will be maintained

The B.M.X. track near the Muscliff Youth Centre was moved to a new site close by for safety reasons.



Cllr Derek stopped the proposed increase in Councillors allowances (salaries) last year, and alongside Councillor Ron refused to take his full entitlement. None of your 3 local independent Ward Councillors claim expenses.



Cllr Derek is at present encouraging schools to make more use of the Athletics Stadium at Kings Park, which at present is under utilised, and is looking for other clubs to use the facilities especially during the winter months.



Due to local government changes the government is giving greater flexibility to local councils, one being to control future house building. We were being forced to possibly build 1,600 new houses in our ward. Local Councillors now have control over this issue and your 3 ward councillors will be constantly monitoring this issue.

We are continuing to fight the budget cuts on disadvantaged residents, plus ensuring that child welfare is maintained outside the ward.



Your 3 local Councillors managed to obtain funding for benches to be installed at Setley Park.



The parking restrictions for Sway Gardens with its junction with Landford Way are being advertised. We hope if this is successful it will increase vision for motorists as they drive out of Sway Gardens, for more details please contact us.
